

Theatrical Weapon Course- Level I (Fundamentals) – Payment Terms and Conditions

Frontline Film Advisors

Effective Date: 01 March 2026

These Payment Terms and Conditions ("Terms") apply to all participants ("Participant" or "Customer") enrolling in the Theatrical Weapons Course ("Course") delivered by **Frontline Film Advisors** ("FFA", "we", "us", "our"). By enrolling in the Course, the Participant agrees to be bound by these Terms.

1. Course Fees and Payment

1.1 Course Fee

The full Course fee is £295 (inclusive of VAT where applicable).

1.2 Payment

The course fee must be paid in full prior to the Course start date.

2. Cancellation Policy – Frontline Film Advisors

2.1 Course Cancellation by FFA

FFA reserves the right to cancel or reschedule the Course due to:

- Insufficient enrolment
- Instructor illness
- Venue unavailability
- Force majeure events (including but not limited to severe weather, government restrictions, or other events beyond our control)

2.2 Refunds in Event of Cancellation by FFA

If FFA cancels the Course:

- Participants will be offered a full refund of all monies paid, **or**
- The option to transfer to a rescheduled date.

FFA shall not be liable for any additional costs incurred by Participants, including but not limited to travel, accommodation, or loss of earnings.

3. Cancellation Policy – Participant

3.1 Cancellation by Participant

All cancellation requests must be made in writing via email.

3.2 Refund Schedule

- More than 30 days before Course start date: course fee refunded.
- 7–30 days before Course start date: 50% of total Course fee refundable.
- Less than 7 days before Course start date: No refund.
- Non-attendance: No refund.

3.3 Transfer of Booking

Participants may request to transfer to a future Course date (subject to availability).

- Transfers requested more than 7 days before the Course may be accommodated at FFA's discretion.
- Only one transfer is permitted per booking.

3.4 Substitution of Participant

A Participant may nominate a substitute attendee at no additional charge, provided written notice is given at least 7 days prior to the Course start date and the substitute meets all Course eligibility requirements.

4. Eligibility and Conduct

4.1 Participants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Provide valid identification upon request.
- Comply with all safety instructions and protocols at all times.

4.2 FFA reserves the right to remove any Participant from the Course without refund if:

- They behave in a manner deemed unsafe, disruptive, or inappropriate.
- They fail to follow safety procedures.
- They are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

5. Health and Safety

5.1 Participants must disclose any relevant medical conditions prior to attending.

5.2 The Course involves the handling of inert, deactivated, or simulated weapons for theatrical purposes under professional supervision. Participants agree to comply fully with all safety briefings and instructions.

5.3 Failure to adhere to safety instructions may result in immediate removal without refund.

6. Liability

6.1 Participants attend the Course at their own risk.

6.2 FFA shall not be liable for:

- Loss or damage to personal property.
- Indirect or consequential loss.
- Travel or accommodation costs due to cancellation or rescheduling.

6.3 Nothing in these Terms excludes liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence or any liability which cannot legally be excluded.

7. Force Majeure

FFA shall not be liable for failure to perform obligations where such failure results from events beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, war, government restrictions, pandemics, strikes, or venue closures.

8. Intellectual Property

All Course materials remain the intellectual property of FFA and may not be reproduced, recorded, distributed, or shared without prior written consent.

9. Photography and Media

FFA may take photographs or video footage during the Course for promotional and educational purposes. Participants who do not wish to appear in media must notify FFA in writing prior to the Course.

10. Governing Law

These Terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

11. Agreement

By enrolling in the Course and making payment, the Participant confirms that they:

- Have read and understood these Payment Terms and Conditions.
- Agree to comply with all safety rules and professional standards.
- Accept the cancellation and refund policies stated herein.
